The Advisory Leadership Council last met on February 21, 2008. The meeting was called to order at 5:15 p.m. by one of the co-chairmen, Gabrielle Guidry.

Each member introduced themselves. The minutes from the last meeting were read and approved as read with no corrections. Old Business was gone over including current enrollment. Also, Achievement Day contests were approved and corrected. Copies of the corrected contests were sent out in February. Members agreed to ask 4-H state officials to be present and to have a specified area for them at the awards ceremony, along with the parish nominees that will be receiving plaques at the ceremony. Members voted on the awards that will be given to the oldest and youngest 4-H members. It was also decided by the members that the Outstanding Club Members will receive goody-bags instead of going through an assembly line that will be stuffed by Junior Leaders. Members also discussed having a "chicken pool" game as a fundraiser and having a special area set up for distinguished guests.

The next meeting was scheduled for Thursday, April 24, 2008 at 5:15pm. Mrs. Liz Angelle made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Len Eisenstein seconded the motion.
