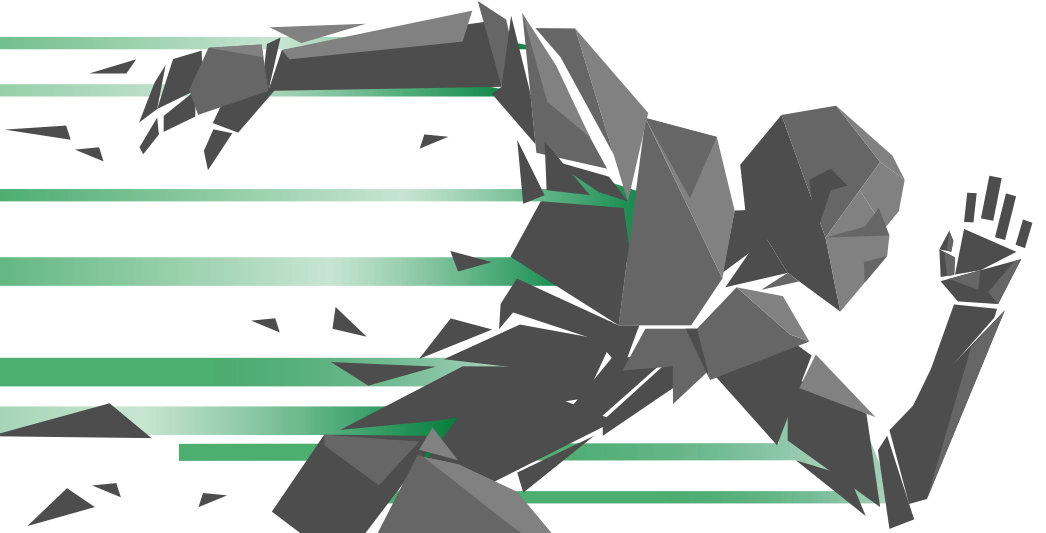

# CLEANING COSTS ARE AN IMPORTANT CONSIDERATION WHEN PURCHASING CLOTHING.

Calculate the cost per wear.

Cost per wearing formula = total price of garment + (cost for care x the # of times cleaned) ÷ the # of times worn per year.

## Cost per wearing figures to use for estimating cleaning costs listed below:

- \$1.50 for machine washing and machine drying
- \$ .50 for hand washing and air-drying
- \$ .75 machine wash and line dry
- \$7.00 for dry cleaning

Contestant's pictures should reflect how they would present themselves and their garment for the day of competition. Contestant should be well-groomed and wearing all accessories desired (i.e.: all jewelry, shoes, belt, hat, bags, etc.). Have fun, be creative. Additional photos may be submitted but are not judged.

Style or put together 3 additional outfits from your closet. LABEL all photos explaining which garments are original to 4-H U outfit and which are additional pieces from closet. Outfits can range from cocktail and dressy, to professional, and from business casual to casual.

- Photos of your 3 additional outfits will be used by the judges for evaluating creativity and appropriateness in styling or putting together outfits.
- Label photos indicating which garment is original to your 4-H U outfit and which are additional pieces from your closet. Each additional outfit must use at least one piece of 4-H U outfit.
- Up to six (6) more photos may be submitted for the additional outfits for the judges.
- Be creative and have fun!
- Judges will score photos
- Judges will score reasons for selection and styling of outfit

3. Ready to Wear test and garment evaluation will take place during the morning of Wednesday, June 22, 2022, at 4-H University
4. Model Ready to Wear outfit for appearance judging during the morning of Wednesday, June 22, 2022, at 4-H University.
5. Contestant must participate in Fashion Show Rehearsal during the afternoon of Wednesday, June 22, 2022, at 4-H University.
6. Contestant must participate in the Fashion Show during the afternoon of Thursday, June 23, 2022, at 4-H University.
