

ENTOMOLOGY DEMONSTRATION

Contest Description:	The entomology contest allows youth to present a method demonstration related to entomology.
Superintendent(s):	Mariah Simoneaux
Award:	Louisiana 4-H Educational Trip
Grade/Age Requirement(s):	Must be enrolled in 8 th to 12 th Grade as of August 1, 2021.
Team or Individual Contest:	Individual or Team of two (2)
Number of Entries Per Parish:	Two (2) Entries

Contest Rules:

1. Refer to Louisiana 4-H University General Rules and Guidelines for a complete set of event rules and guidelines.
2. Must be a method demonstration, not an illustrated talk.
3. Refer to the “Educational Presentation” scoresheet for guidance when preparing the content of your demonstration.
4. 4-H members will have an opportunity to use Power Point or posters, all equipment will be provided (easel will be provided upon request).
5. Demonstration should be planned for eight (8) to fifteen (15) minutes. If a presentation is not in the allocated time, one point will be deducted for each minute or fraction thereof up to five minutes. Five points will be deducted for each minute or fraction thereof over five minutes.
6. Any topic relating to entomology can be demonstrated. Topics include management, prevention, remediation, and safety prevention in addition to insect control. Examples are pest control, mite control, millipede control, insecticide mixing, pesticide (insecticide) safety, pest management, beekeeping (apiculture).
7. Members with a demonstration which needs to be set-up outdoors must notify the contest superintendent by June 10, 2022.
