

## FASHION REVUE - IT'S SEW YOU

<b>Contest Description:</b>	4-H U Fashion Revue is a part of an educational program sponsored by the LSU AgCenter. It consists of three different contest categories. In the Fashion Revue Program, 4-H members are evaluated based on consumer decision making, quality analysis, quality of construction or workmanship, degree of difficulty, modeling, fit and appearance. <b>It's SEW You</b> contestants construct (sew) an outfit and are judged on garment construction and appearance. You are encouraged to use fabrics, patterns, and notions that you already have available if you desire. Fabrics, patterns, and supplies can be purchased wherever available whether locally or online. The contestant may choose a commercial pattern, create their own or use a combination of each. Garment and Data Packet are submitted for judging prior to deadline and include photos, information about pattern and fabric choice, construction, care of garment, experiences, and challenges.

<b>Award:</b>	National 4-H Congress trip for first place winner. Second place receives a serger or sewing machine.
<b>Grade/Age Requirement(s):</b>	Must be enrolled in 8 <sup>th</sup> to 12 <sup>th</sup> Grade as of August 1, 2021.
<b>Team or Individual Contest:</b>	Individual
<b>Number of Entries Per Parish:</b>	Three (3) per parish

### Contest Rules:

1. Refer to Louisiana 4-H University General Rules and Guidelines for a complete set of event rules and guidelines.
2. Contestant may not enter a garment that was entered in any previous State 4-H University Fashion Revue Contest. A garment entered local, parish, and regional events may be entered in state contest.
3. All entries must be a complete outfit. May be any number of pieces but may not contain more pieces than can be worn at one time. Contestants must complete a constructed garment (dress/jumpsuit or top/shirt/blouse with skirt/shorts/pants) prior the June 10, 2022, deadline.
4. Contestants must do all construction on sewn garments. Accessories such as belts, scarves and purses that are purchased ready-made should not be submitted for construction judging but worn for appearance judging and fashion show.
5. Data packet and garment must be submitted to Knapp Hall, LSU Campus by June 10, 2022.
6. Garments will be available for pickup at 4-H U registration on Tuesday, June 21, 2022. Details for Fashion Revue Week, competition numbers and Fashion Show line up numbers will be found in the 4-H Agent's Parish registration packet.
7. During 4-H University, Wednesday morning contest, contestants will model 4-H U outfit for appearance judging.
8. Contestants will participate in Fashion Show rehearsal held in designated location on Wednesday afternoon.
9. Contestants will model outfits for the 4-H U Fashion Show held Thursday afternoon at the Fashion Revue designated location.
