

## FASHION REVUE - READY TO WEAR CONTEST

<b>Contest Description:</b>	4-H U Fashion Revue is a part of an educational program sponsored by the LSU AgCenter. It consists of three different contest categories. In the Fashion Revue Program, 4-H members are evaluated based on consumer decision making, quality analysis, quality of construction or workmanship, degree of difficulty, modeling, fit and appearance. <b>Ready to Wear Selections and Judging</b> contestants put together a 4-H u outfit and accessories for an occasion of their choice. Contestants may select an outfit from their closet, shop retail store or online. 4-H U outfit pieces may be all ready-to-wear or a combination of home sewn and ready-to-wear.

<b>Grade/Age Requirement(s):</b>	Must be enrolled in 8 <sup>th</sup> to 12 <sup>th</sup> Grade as of August 1, 2021.

<b>Number of Entries Per Parish:</b>	Three (3) per parish

### Contest Rules:

1. Refer to Louisiana 4-H University General Rules and Guidelines for a complete set of event rules and guidelines.
2. Contestant may not enter a garment that was entered in any previous State 4-H U Fashion Revue Contest. A garment entered at local, parish, and regional events may be entered in State Contest.
3. All entries must be a complete outfit. May be any number of pieces but may not contain more pieces than can be worn at one time.
4. Garments are not submitted for judging, only the data packet.
5. Data packet must be submitted online by June 10, 2022. Online submission information will be located under contest rules at [www.lsuagcenter.com/4hu](http://www.lsuagcenter.com/4hu)
6. Contestants are limited to spending \$100 and does not include shoes and accessories unless they were purchased as a part of the outfit.
7. In addition to the main outfit, contestants will create 3 more outfits with pieces chosen from their closet that will change up their 4-H U outfit to be casual or dress. The three additional outfits must include at least one piece of the original 4-H U outfit.
8. Contestants will be evaluated on consumer judging skills and will rank two sets of garments and answer questions on the overall quality of the appearance and construction details. Fibers, fabrics, garment care, label information and cost of garment are items that contestants will evaluate.
9. Details for Fashion Revue Week, competition numbers and Fashion Show line up numbers will be found in the 4-H Agents registration packet.
10. During 4-H University, Wednesday morning contest, contestants will model 4-H U outfit for appearance judging and take the Ready to Wear test and evaluate garments.
11. Contestants will participate in Fashion Show Rehearsal held in designated location on Wednesday afternoon.
12. Contestants will model outfit for the 4-H U Fashion Show held Thursday afternoon in designated location.
