

Premier Exhibitor General Rules

- 1. The Premier Exhibitor Program is optional. To participate, an exhibitor must be available for each activity at the specified times.
- 2. Only senior level exhibitors are eligible to compete (Grades 9th through 12th).
- 3. Premier Exhibitor Programs are available for Beef, Dairy, Poultry, Sheep, Swine, Goat and Horse Projects. An exhibitor may compete in one or more Premier Exhibitor Programs provided they exhibit a qualified animal at the LSU AgCenter State Livestock and Poultry Show or State 4-H/FFA Horse Show in Baton Rouge for each project resume submitted.
- 4. All resumes (entry forms) must be in the State Livestock Show Office by January 18 for Livestock and July 1 for Horse of the participating year to be eligible to compete. A different resume (entry form) must be submitted for each project.
- 5. Awards will be presented to the top 5 exhibitors in each project.
- 6. All decisions are final and are not subject to protests.
- 7. An exhibitor may be named Premier Exhibitor in a project only once.
- 8. Written exam questions will be taken from project books and LCES numbered publications unless otherwise noted.
