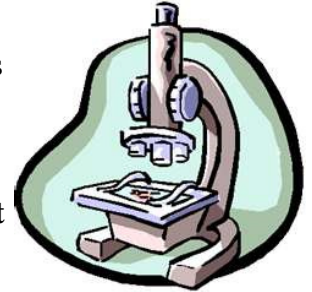
L.O.S.T. CAMP
